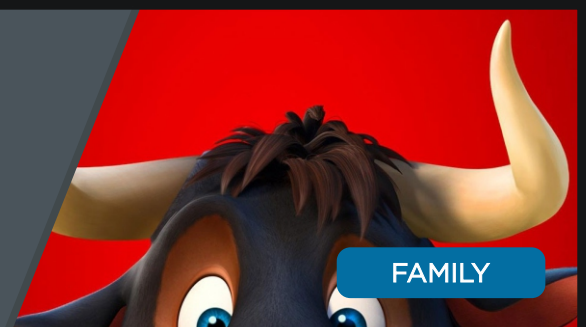
PADDINGTON 2
